As our region, customer base, and energy needs continue to grow, we are committed to providing reliable power.

- Newman Unit 6 is a state-of-the-art 228 megawatt (MW) natural gas generation unit
- We will replace three older, less-efficient units that are 60+ years old (Newman Units 1 & 2, and Rio Grande Unit 7)
- 600 million gallons of water per year will be saved
- Is located at the existing Newman Power Station in Northeast El Paso, TX
- Is capable of turning on and off within minutes to quickly respond to customer energy usage and the variability of renewable sources
- EPE is a regulated utility providing electricity and does not produce natural gas
- EPE meets all environmental standards

Newman Unit 6 is needed to continue to provide reliable power while unleashing EPE's renewable energy potential.

Economic Impact Analysis

Newman Unit 6 will be replacing three 60+ year old units and will generate a strong economic impact for our region.

The Economic Impact Analysis estimates a **total regional economic impact of \$105 million.**
