INTERRUPTION AND/OR SHORTAGE OF SUPPLY

Furthermore, the Company will not be liable for damages occasioned by interruption of service when such are necessary to make repairs involving the Company's equipment and facilities.

In the event that there shall be a shortage in the supply of service through no fault of the Company, the Company may undertake a load-shedding plan as may be prescribed by the regulatory authorities in the best interests of the customers thus affected.
